

Amesiella philippinensis



Native of: Philippines

Habitat: An epiphyte that grows in montane forest at about 800m

Description: A miniature plant with 4cm leaves and large 4cm flowers on short stems with one to three flowers per stem.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species warm (min.18°C) and mounted.

Flowering season Spring

Flask to flowering approx. 2 years
