

Angraecum birrimense



Native of: Central and East Africa

Habitat: Evergreen forest.

Description: Plant has elongated stems up to 2m long with two flowered inflorescences produced along the stem. The flowers are 12cm in diameter and heavily scented.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar plants mounted and hot (min18°C). It has been suggested that this will grow well up a moss pole.

Flowering season: not known

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs
