

Angraecum-compactum



Native of: Madagascar

Habitat: It is wide spread epiphyte in Madagascar from the lower eastern slopes on up into the dryer forests of the central plateau, ranging from 700 -2000m.

Description: Small plant with large flowers white in front greenish behind, it has a lovely spicy fragrance in the evenings. Flowers around June.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species mounted on cork bark but would grow in a pot. It should grow well warm/intermediate because of its altitude range.

Flowering season: June

Flask to flowering approx: 2yrs.
