

Angraecum dryadum



Native of: Madagascar

Habitat: Epiphyte in Northern Madagascar ranging from 1000 -2000m.

Description: Small plant up to 25cm tall with large flowers 5cm across white in front greenish behind, it has a lovely spicy fragrance in the evenings.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species mounted on cork bark but would grow in a pot. It should grow well warm/intermediate because of its altitude range.

Flowering season: June

Flask to flowering approx: 2yrs.
