

Angraecum germinyanum



Native of: Madagascar and the Comoro islands

Habitat: Epiphyte that grows in the central plateau.

Description: Medium sized plant that has a very long & many branched stem. Single flowers grow out of the stem at many points the individual flowers which are large & spidery with a large white lip & yellow green petals sepals & spur.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species to this mounted, but can be grown in pots, warm (min 18°C) low to medium light.

Flowering season: march to october

Flask to flowering approx: 3yrs.
