


# Diaphananthe kamerunensis

**Native of:** West Africa

**Habitat:** Epiphytic in evergreen forest and woodland, 1000-1800m

**Description:** Has the Diaphananthe. A medium sized plant with 35cm leaves and pendent 12 flower stems carrying 5 to 10 translucent pale green or creamy yellow. The flowers are 3-4cm across with a large fan shaped fringed lip.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow similar plants mounted and hot (min18°C) in low light. It is reported that this species requires high humidity.

**Flowering season:** ?

**Flask to flowering approx:** 2-3yrs
