

Aeranthus longipes



Native of: Madagascar

Habitat: This plant grows at around 1000m as an epiphyte in low light.

Description: A small growing plant with green flowers 3cm wide on long thin pendulous stems up to 10cm long.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this warm (min.15°C) And keep it well watered throughout the year in low light. The plant flowers of the same stems for several years, so don't cut old flower stems off.

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.
