

Bulbophyllum occlusum



Native of: Madagascar.

Habitat: An epiphyte in forests below 1500m altitude.

Description: A medium sized plant 30cm high that produces spikes of up to 30 flowers each 2.5cm long.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species in pots or baskets and warm (min 15°C).

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx. 5yrs.
