

Bulbophyllum tollenoniferum



Native of: Papua New Guinea.

Habitat: An epiphyte in forests up to 700m altitude, prefers branches at the forest edge.

Description: A medium sized plant that produces large glossy yellow/green flowers. See 'Orchids of Papua New Guinea' by Andree Millar to for photographs of pollination by fruit flies.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species in pots or baskets and warm (min 15°C).

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx. 5yrs.
