

Cyrtorchis arcuata subsp. whytei



Native of: Tropical Africa

Habitat: An epiphyte in riverine forest or in wet evergreen forest often in deep shade from 750 to 2000 meters.

Description: Medium sized plant with 8cm white flowers many on each stem. Young plants produce a few flowers at a time while mature plants are covered in flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species mounted but it would also grow in a pot. We grow it hot (min18°C) but it should cope cooler than this. In the wild it grows in low light.

Flowering season: winter

Flask to flowering approx: 3yr
