

Dendrochilum filiforme



Native of: Philippines

Habitat: An epiphyte in forest from 700 to 2000 meters.

Description: A small growing plant with 18cm leaves. The very thin flower stems emerge from new growths in June and eventually become pendulous carrying many tiny flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species cool (min10°C) but it should cope warmer than this. We give lots of water during the summer but less in the winter when resting.

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 3yr
