

# Diaphananthe pellucida



**Native of:** Tropical Africa

**Habitat:** Epiphyte in evergreen rainforest from 600 to 1500m

**Description:** A medium sized plant with 30cm leaves. The 40cm flower stems have many creamy yellow flowers just over 1cm across.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow similar plants mounted and hot (min18°C) in low light. It's habitat suggests it should be happy cooler than this.

**Flowering season:** autumn/winter

**Flask to flowering approx:** 3yrs
