

Promenaea xanthina



Native of: Brazil

Habitat: Epiphytic in forests at around 1700m altitude.

Description: This is a small plant with 7cm leaves that produces 4cm flowers on short stems. The species will form specimen plants with masses of flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species cool (min.10°C) in pots and baskets. It seems to grow best near a fan for good air movement.

Flowering season: Spring/Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 3-4yrs.

Seed source: Private grower
