

Rangaeris amaniensis



Native of: South Eastern Africa

Habitat: Montane forest from 1000 to 2600m.

Description: A medium sized plant with 10cm leaves and 4cm flowers with spurs up to 16cm long.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species mounted and warm (min15°C) but its distribution suggests it should be happy grown cooler.

Flowering season: August

Flask to flowering approx. 3yrs
