

## Barbosella handroi



**Native of:** Brazil

**Habitat:** A epiphyte in damp forest from 1200- 1400m

**Description:** A tiny plant with a single 1 cm leaf on short stems. The plant produces flower spikes 2cm long each with a 1cm brown/yellow flower.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school this species succeeds cool (min.10°C) with lots of water in the summer.

**Flowering season:** Autumn
