

# Brassia verrucosa



**Native of:** Central America

**Habitat:** An epiphyte found in damp forest up to 1600m

**Description:** A medium sized plant that produces many 70cm spikes with up to 20 long lasting flowers with sepals up to 12cm long.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school this species succeeds cool (min.10°C) or warm (min15°C) good light and water throughout the year.

**Flowering season:** Summer

**Flask to flowering approx:** 4yrs.

**Seedling source –** Writhlington
