

Cattleya nobelior var rosea



Native of: Brazil

Habitat: An epiphyte in seasonally dry forest along rivers near the coast.

Description: A short bifoliate Cattleya with 1-3 intermediate sized flowers up to 12cm in diameter. The plants grow to 12cm high and the flowers are produced on spikes from the base of last years pseudobulb.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species warm (min 15°C). Its natural habitat suggests it needs good light and a dry rest during the winter.

Flowering season: Feb/March

Flask to flowering approx: 6yrs.
