

Coelogyne graminifolia



Native of: China, Burma, Thailand to Malaysia

Habitat: An epiphyte in forest at around 1000-2000m.

Description: A medium sized plant with long lasting fragrant 5cm flowers with up to four 15cm arching spikes.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this cool (min.10°C) wet in the summer dryish in winter.

Flowering season: Summer
