

Coelogyne massangeana



Native of: South East Asia

Habitat: An epiphyte in forest at around 200-1000m.

Description: A medium sized plant with 4cm flowers on long pendulous spikes with up to twenty flowers per spike.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this warm (min.15°C) wet in the summer dryish in winter.

We like to grow plants in baskets to allow the flower spikes to develop.

Flowering season: Summer
