

Maxillaria meleagris



Native of: Mexico and Guatemala

Habitat: growing epiphytically on trees from 1500 – 2500m altitude.

Description: Medium sized plant with smooth 5cm pseudobulbs and leaves 30cm long. The 5cm flowers are produced on short stems from the base of the pseudobulb.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species cool (min 10°C) in medium light.

Flowering season: March/April
