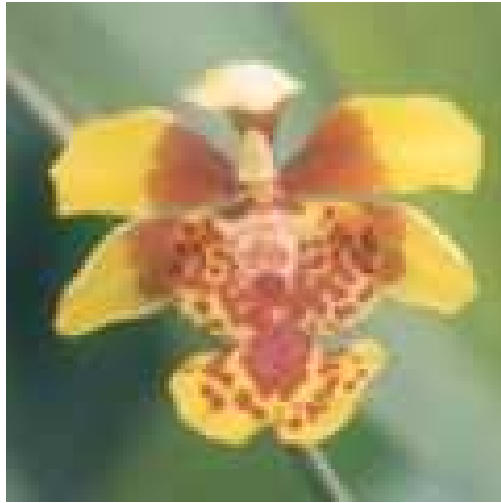


Oncidium divaricatum



Native of: Brazil

Habitat: A epiphyte in damp forest at around 1500m

Description: A medium sized plant with a single 30cm leaf to each bulb. The plant produces flower spikes up to 2m long with up to 100 2.5cm flowers spread on branches.

Cultivation Guidance: At school this species succeeds cool (min.10°C) good light with lots of water in the summer but dryish in the winter.

Flowering season: Autumn

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.

Seedling source – Commercial nursery
