

Aerangis confusa



Native of: Kenya & Tanzania

Habitat: At low level on tree trunks in shade, mostly in hilly areas 1600 to 2100 m.

Description: Small plant with medium white flowers with a pink tinge. From 4 to 10 flowers on each stem.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min18°C) in low light.

Flowering season: Early summer & again in late autumn

Flask to flowering approx: 2yrs
